ZEUS/WALEDAC RELATED ISSUES AT STATE OF TENNESSEE

- After some research, the SIRT has determined that the Zeus/Waledac hits at the state are being caused (in whole or in part) by the installation of certain toolbars, one possible offender being the "Shop-at-Home" toolbar. The pc's should have this and other possibly offending toolbars removed. Thank you for your continued cooperation and vigilance.
- On April 13, 2010, Microsoft issued 11 security bulletins for a variety of its software products including Windows operating systems, Publisher and Media Player. Enterprise WSUS participants will receive update notifications from tenn.update services (See attached).
